I am Apostolic, because ...

Apostolic is derived from the word apostle. Apostles are, who Jesus taught in the New Testament to build the church of God after the death of Jesus Christ. We are apostolic, we are solved and we have dedicated our God, lead to the heritage of the apostles under the guidance of our God Jesus Christ.

So we are all disciples of Jesus. But we are apostolic and not new apostolic, because the Bible, since it was written, has never changed and the word of God have existed 2,000 years ago. God, the Lord Jesus Christ has changed nothing of them.

For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. (Matthew 5, 18)

It is often said that the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God, which was intended only for the apostles and not for everyone. But the truth is, would the Holy Spirit was intended only for the Apostles, it would have been temporary, so fleeting, because the apostles are all I know, death. But our God Jesus Christ, is forever and so is the Spirit of God intended for everyone, because the Holy Spirit bring the people into eternity.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. (Romans 8, 9)

Apostle comes from the Greek *Apóstolos* or the Aramaic *saliah* and means so much as an Messenger or Emissary¹. He is a disciple of Jesus and a Messenger of God.

- I am Apostolic, because I see the task of the apostles to preach that gospel pure and so obey the will and the word of God. I speak where the Bible speaks and silent where the Bible I was silent. So I'm going to go and spread the "good news", the "message of victory" of good over evil and believe in the characters that will follow.

 (Matthew 28,19-20; Mark 13,10; 16,15-18; John 21,15-17; Acts 14,7).
- I am Apostolic, because I'm not a guest or stranger anymore, but a member of the church of God. I'm at home in the house of God and in the family of my brothers and sisters. I will obey, because I am called in the name of Jesus Christ to serve those who need the help of God. (Ephesians 2,19-22, Romans 1,5-6; Hebrews 11,8; Romans 8,30; John 15,16; Acts 26,22).
- I am Apostolic, because I will baptize people in water in the name of Jesus Christ, so that he who repents will be redeemed from sin and be renewed by Water and the Spirit. (Marc 16,16; John 11,25; Acts 2,38; 22,16; Romans 6,3; 1Peter 3,21; John 3,5).
- I am Apostolic, because I believe in healing by the elders, those who heals through prayer and anointing the sick with oil in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. (*James 5,14-15*)
- I am Apostolic, because God will equip me for this task with his power from on high. I will stay in the community, to which I am baptized with the Holy Spirit. I shall speak with new tongues and other languages. In his name I will cast out devils and serpents and heal the sick. I'll hang up my hands and people will be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ with the Holy Spirit. (Luc 24,49; Acts 2,1-4; 2,38-39)

- I am Apostolic, because I believe in the One, all-powerful and living God, the Lord Jesus Christ. I believe that I'm a member of the one body of Jesus Christ that unites us to the one faith in Jesus Christ and I believe in one baptism, in which we are baptized through and with Jesus Christ. I believe in one God and Father whose Spirit works in everybody. I believe in one spirit with Him. (Deotoronomy 6,4; Marc 12,29+32; Isaiah 44.6; 45,5; 46,9; 1Corinthians 6,17; 8,6; Ephesians 4,4-6; 1Timotheus 2.5; James 2:19).
- I am Apostolic, because I check everything I get and check everything on the basis of Scripture and study every day whether it also behaves as it is written in the Bible. For I believe that the word of God came from heaven to earth and took human form in the person of Jesus Christ. Who sacrificed for all of us and defeated the evil by the blood he has sacrificed for us humans. (John 1,1-3; 4,1-3; 8,19; 8,58, 10,30, 12,45; 1 Thessalonians 5, 21; 1Timothy 3,16; Matthew 16,16; 1 John 1,1+5+8; Colossians 1,17; 1 Corinthians 3,22; 12,4).
- I'm Apostolic because I believe in the Spirit of God. In the Comforter, the Holy Spirit in us, because our body is the temple of God. So God is in us by His Spirit. Through the Holy Spirit we will achieve justice and be saved to eternal life through Jesus Christ. By the baptism with the Holy Spirit God blessed us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The gift of wisdom, knowledge, the gift of to make heal and the gift of miracles. The gift of prophetic speech, to distinguish different spirit. The gift of tongues and the gift of interpretation of tongues. These are all the gifts of the Holy Spirit and each one can get all the gifts, if he wants. (John 15,26-27; 1Corinthians 3,16; 6,14; 12,1-11; Romans 8:9,14,16; 14,17; 1Peter 4,14; Matthew 12,28; 1John 5,6; Exodus 35,31; Acts 4,31).
- I am Apostolic, because I am a member of the body of Christ. So there are many members of the body of Jesus Christ and none are alike. So the body has many members yet one body. So we are united in the spirit of Jesus Christ and are God's fellow workers. Thus, each member body on Jesus Christ has his specific task. So we are all members of the church of God, God's people. Thus, there are many tasks to be fulfilled. There are apostles, prophets, teachers, and miracle worker. (1Corinthians 3,9-11; 6,15; 12,12-31; Romans 12,4; Ephesians 4,25; 5,30; Colossians 3,5; Matthew 5,29-30; Number 16:3,19; Matthew 18,17; Hebrews 4,9; Sirach 24,16; Judith 5,15).
- I am Apostolic, because I pray without ceasing. So I pray for what I want and God will grant me. People are healed by and on behalf of Jesus Christ. The country is in which we live is healed. So we ask God to forgive our sins and God will separate us from sin, He holy us, and our soul is healed. So we are cured of this world. (Marc 5,29; Psalms 33,20; 65,3; 86,6; 88,14; 2Chronicles 7,14; Colossians 4,2; Matthew 21,22; Philippians 1,4; Ephesians 1,16; John 15,7-8; Acts 2,42; Proverbs 28,9; Job 16,17).
- I am Apostolic, because I have the love of God. For God is love and he loves me. He has shown me his love, when he was hit on the cross for my fault, my fault for using his blood, which He shed for me to wash. So I love my God, the Lord Jesus Christ with all my heart and with all your soul. But love is not a gift but a fruit. God teaches us to love through His spirit. I pray for my brothers and sister, for the love that we have with each other, because one will recognize us. If we love Jesus Christ because he is our God and Creator, and he has done everything a father can do for his children. So we obey his word and follow his law, because we love him so much. (Exodus 2,15; Ephesians 2,4;5,25; 1Tessalonians 4,9; 1John 3,16; Hosea 11,4; 14,5; Deotoronomy 6,5; 10,2; Matthew 22,36-40; Marc 12,29-31;

- 1Corinthians 2,9; 8,32; 16,22; John 8,42; Roman 13,8-10; Hebrews 6,10; Psalms 91,14; Proverbs 8,17)
- I am Apostolic, because I believe in God, the heavenly Father who created everything. I believe in the Son of God, the Word became flesh and Jesus Christ became man. The one who could be slaughtered for human sin as the Lamb of God and the people from evil ransomed by the blood that he gave for us, that man is reconciled with the God who created in and whose word he has not followed. I believe in the Holy Spirit, who comforts us, as long as this world is, because by and with Jesus Christ we shall be saved, and the glory and power of God now have been here on earth. (Genesis 1,1; 1John 4,14; John 1,10; Revelation 1,17; 2Corinthians 3,17).
